Dear Student Drivers and Parents,

The 2017 Spring Session of the Red Lodge Traffic Education course will begin with a required STUDENT and PARENT orientation meeting scheduled for March 13th (2017) at 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Red Lodge Middle (Roosevelt) School Commons Area. Parents/guardian(s) are required to attend or the student will be dropped from TSE. If you cannot make it, you need to schedule an alternative time before March 13th, 2017-the date of your parent meeting.

The meeting will outline the course schedule, requirements and expectations.

The course is limited to the first 15 students who have registered and payed with the RLHS and RLMS Office and meet the following criteria:

- Academically eligible
- Demonstrate responsibility
- Pay a \$200.00 course fee. (\$100 in Non-Refundable). Make check payable to **Red Lodge High School.**
- Must be 15 by 6 months from date of when you start class

The course is scheduled to run from March 13th through the end of May, possibly early June. (You will be updated with an exact end date at the Parent Meeting). Schedule is tentative to any changes that may occur during the spring session. We will meet Monday through Friday (With possibility of only having class 3 days a week, alternating class with drives) at 6:15 a.m.-7:45 a.m. with an additional driving schedule that will be provided at the orientation meeting. As of right now, all classes will be held at the Roosevelt Middle School-Commons Area (May change to a room as we get closer to the start of class.) Parent drop-offs/pick-ups from class and drives will also be at the Red Lodge Middle School-Roosevelt.

Please bring the following information/documentation to the Student/ Parent Orientation:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Student Social Security Card
- Proof of physical address (Mailed envelope, bill, etc.)

Please understand that daily course attendance is mandatory. Exceptions will not be made for appointments, vacations or tardy/late arrivals in accordance with guidelines established by the Montana Office of Public Instruction, Traffic Education Division.

Additional questions, and course details will be covered at the orientation meeting.
